The Run My Way Grant Program forms part of Transport for NSW's multi-year collaboration with the Office of Sport under the Safer Cities Program, [Run My Way](#), which is aimed at increasing women, girls and gender diverse people's active and meaningful participation in running.

Purpose

The NSW Government's Run My Way Grant Program supports running clubs to deliver initiatives that improve perceptions of safety and create more welcoming, inclusive and accessible running environments for women, girls and gender-diverse people.

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The Program recognises that concerns about personal safety can be a barrier to participation in running and physical activity. Funding will support running clubs to implement practical measures, programs and partnerships that help participants feel safer, more confident and connected when running in their communities.

Through these grants, the NSW Government aims to foster inclusive running environments that encourage participation, strengthen community connections and contribute to safer public spaces across NSW.

- Improve perceptions of safety for women, girls and gender-diverse people participating in running.

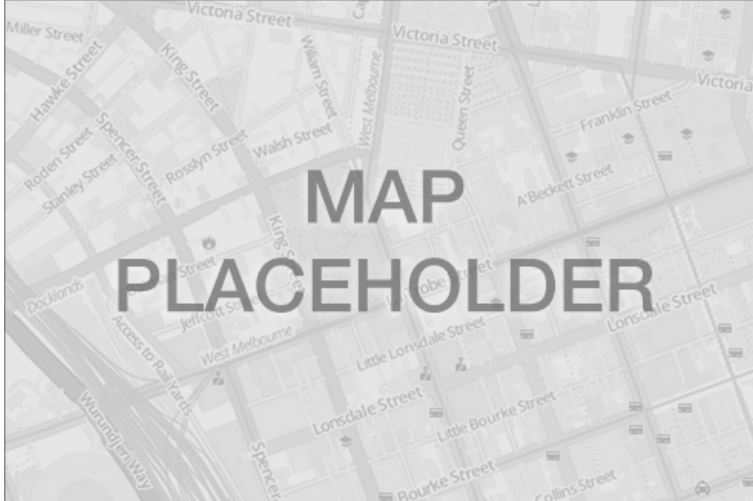

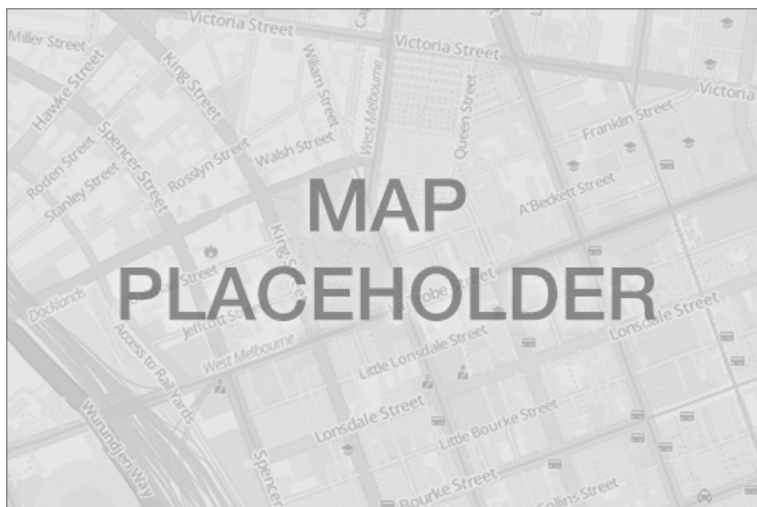
